

Intentionally Equips God's People For Christ's Mission

The following questions are meant to give you a general diagnosis in regard to Equipping Leaders. You must be honest, even if it is painful. An answer that does not reflect the truth about you may give you a higher score and cause you to feel better about yourself but it will not ultimately challenge you to be more wise and adept in your use of the scriptures. If you do not know the answer to a question the answer is probably, “no.” If you are not satisfied with “no,” ask your spouse.

Please answer the following questions “yes” or “no.”

1. I encourage and motivate volunteers often.
2. I enjoy coaching other people to become their best for Christ.
3. I have identified clear roles for those who are on my team and have helped them to understand the function of those roles.
4. I regularly cast the God's vision to those I am leading.
5. I am providing opportunities for others to lead.
6. I am clear about my personal calling so that others have confidence in following.
7. I am always on the look out for new leaders.
8. I have an intentional plan to develop leaders.
9. I am willing to release leaders God has raised up under my ministry.
10. Those closest to me would say that I am good at releasing the leader in everyone on our team.
11. I understand the difference between a team leader and a task leader.
12. I spend time in prayer asking God to raise up leaders for the harvest.
13. I have a healthy sense of who I am, where I've come from, and what my values, likes, passions, dislikes that enables me to lead with Christ confidence. (John 13:3).

Scoring

If you scored “yes” 7 or more times it would seem that you have achieved a good degree of health in this area. Continue to practice the things that brought you this health. If you scored “yes” 5 times or less you definitely need to give attention to

this area of your life. A score of 5 or less will make it difficult to spiritually lead others without encountering difficulty and in fact you may even sabotage your own leadership with such a lack.
