INTERNATIONAL MISSIONS

CALEB SPANNAGEL had the opportunity to serve as a Missionary Explorer in Colombia and Peru, primarily in the Amazon jungle. Serving as a missionary explorer involves going to people groups located in places where few others are willing to go. Caleb had three main tasks: the first was to constantly abide in Christ. Secondly, he was responsible for researching unreached and unengaged people groups, identifying the challenges and barriers that hinder the spread of the Gospel. Thirdly, he was called to carry out the Great Commission by sharing the Gospel.

Through his research, Caleb confirmed that 22 of the 24 groups he visited had no believers and no church. He continues to pray that God will raise up people who are called to help reach these groups.

His work was made possible by CNBC churches that gave to the **Great Commission Offering** and by all those who faithfully prayed for him.
